Training for Case Planning and eCornerstone

At the end of this year, eCornerstone will be enhanced to include a complete case planning function. Intake, assessment and case planning functions will be available to all youth service providers using eCornerstone. At this time, Phase Two of eCornerstone implementation will kick-off. Introduction of new functions and the addition of new users provided the Department of Human Services with an opportunity to reformat the instructional requirements of eCornerstone.

The greatest change is the format of the YASI and eCornerstone instruction. The two, two-day YASI courses and the single day eCornerstone training have been combined into a four day course. The concepts underlying the development of a case plan as presented in YASI I & II will be covered in three days. Hands-on application of case planning using eCornerstone will be conducted on the fourth day. Evaluation results from Phase One of eCornerstone implementation and consideration of limited local and state resources prompted this new format. Further, the four-day course will be offered in several regional locations in addition to Springfield and Chicago.

Those youth services providers that are part of the Phase Two eCornerstone implementation will receive information pertaining to Case Planning training approximately six weeks from the scheduled eCornerstone live date. This information will be provided by the DHS regional representative during the eCornerstone orientation meeting. The regional representative will assist each agency with identifying the staff who should receive eCornerstone training. Remember that IDHS requires that anyone using the eCornerstone system must attend the entire four-day Case Planning training.

The Youth Network Council will coordinate registration for the Case Planning course. However, the course schedule is pre-determined for each youth services agency by the eCornerstone implementation schedule. A copy of the Phase Two implementation schedule accompanies this bulletin.

Arrangements are in place to accommodate current eCornerstone users who have not attended the original YASI instruction. Users that have attended none of the YASI trainings must contact the Youth Network Council. YNC will register the user in the earliest and closest class available in the Phase Two implementation schedule. eCornerstone users that have participated only in YASI I are to contact YNC to register for one of several YASI II trainings offered through December.

As noted earlier, the department made these changes based on input from providers. Please continue to provide input, it is valued and put to use.
