eCornerstone and eLearning

The Illinois Department of Human Services is pleased to announce that the eCornerstone Teen REACH training will be delivered in a web-based format. That means no traveling for eCornerstone training. You will be able to access the eCornerstone Teen REACH training via the computer on your desktop, your computer at home, or any computer with an Internet connection.

The department, in partnership with the Springfield Urban League/Community Health Training Center (CHTC), has developed a web-based interactive "eLearning" training application for Teen REACH. This application is a state-of-the-art series of courses that may be accessed via the CHTC web site.

eLearning uses an interactive approach of video animations and audio voice-over to demonstrate the eCornerstone system. You will log in to the training web page and navigate the entire course, with supporting materials such as flow sheets, guidelines, policies and procedures, and a glossary of terms available from a Download Center at the same web site. You may print and review these materials prior to taking the web-based course.

Navigation from page to page is an important feature of the Teen REACH_eLearning production. Along with the web-based demonstration of each function, this training will walk you through the actual step-by-step instructions to complete each page of the eCornerstone application. Post-test questions throughout the course will prompt you to review items learned.

The web-based training course will be available for local agency viewing later this month. Before then, a PDF document called "Preflight" will be sent via e-mail detailing the necessary steps to prepare you and your computer for the Teen REACH eLearning production. In it, you will learn how to access the necessary software and training materials required by the training sessions. You also will be directed to the Community Health Training Center's web site where the training may be accessed.
