



eCornerstone Application Update

The following changes to the eCornerstone system will be deployed and effective on September 22, 2003 (version 1.1.3.5). GENERAL INFORMATION

The **eCornerstone Reference Manual** has been updated with all changes and additions outlined in this document.

SYSTEM CHANGES AND ENHANCEMENTS

- The **termination of a case worker** can now take place prior to reassigning their caseload. The system will warn the Security Coordinator if the case worker they are terminating has an active caseload. Following the termination of the caseworker whose caseload has not already been reassigned, the terminated caseworker's caseload will appear on the Home Page under "Inactive Cases". (Only workers who are granted the Assignment role are able to view Inactive Cases.) The caseload will remain there until the case is reassigned.

- **Scoring in the Legal History** section of the YASI assessment has been revised, which may result in changes of 4 (four) points in existing YASI scores. Under certain circumstances, a base score of 4 (four) was created depending upon the participant's age that was entered, when actually a base score of 0 (zero) should have been created.
- **Attention Security Coordinators:** When adding a new worker into the User Administration module for eCornerstone, the generic password formerly used is no longer valid. Instead, when the Security Coordinators adds a new worker, a random password will be generated when the "Reset Password" option is chosen. The Security Coordinator will share the password with the worker, who will then reset the random password with their own.
